Corona hired three part-time music ministry staff in September. Keith Schemper is the new contemporary worship director, C.J. Garbo is the new choir director, and Paul ljames is the new accompanist for the Heritage Service.

#### **Keith Schemper**

Keith has been playing in worship bands since the 8th grade when he got his first drum set. His first leadership position was at Trinity Christian College in Palos Heights, IL, where he led the weekly student-led worship service. Since college he has held several full-time worship director positions. Keith plays the drums, the keyboards and the guitar.

"For me, the most important part of a church is its people," Keith said. "The people of Corona are kind and genuine and are active in ministry. It is a joy to join a church in its ministry."

Keith is a second-year graduate student at the University of Denver studying International Disaster Psychology. He and his wife, Shannon, have been attending City Presbyterian Church at the Tivoli downtown on Sunday mornings.

They have been married for three years. Shannon works at the University of Denver in the Women's College. They live four blocks from Corona.

#### Paul ljames

Paul has been an accompanist or music director for churches in North Carolina since 2001. He has experience with a variety of musical styles, including traditional, gospel, Latin, and African-American. He developed a blended worship style
